Perhaps you're eclectic with a wonderful sense of putting just the right things together?

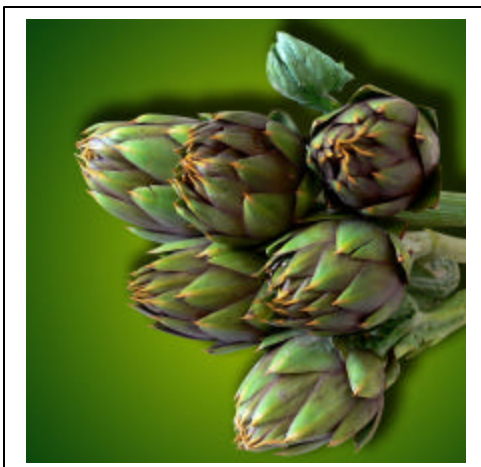
Whatever your style – Color will define your personality!

You can find any number of books relating to the subject of color for your home. What is the latest trend? What do the colors mean? Or how about a color wheel showing what colors co-ordinate with another?

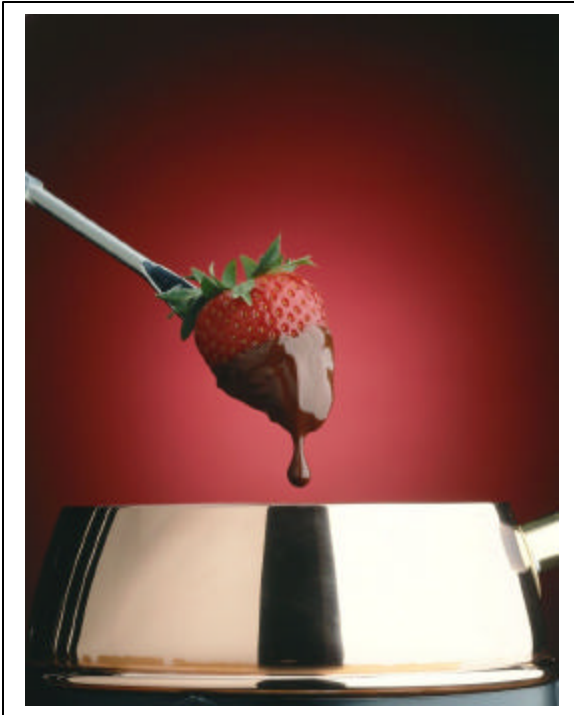

A few examples:

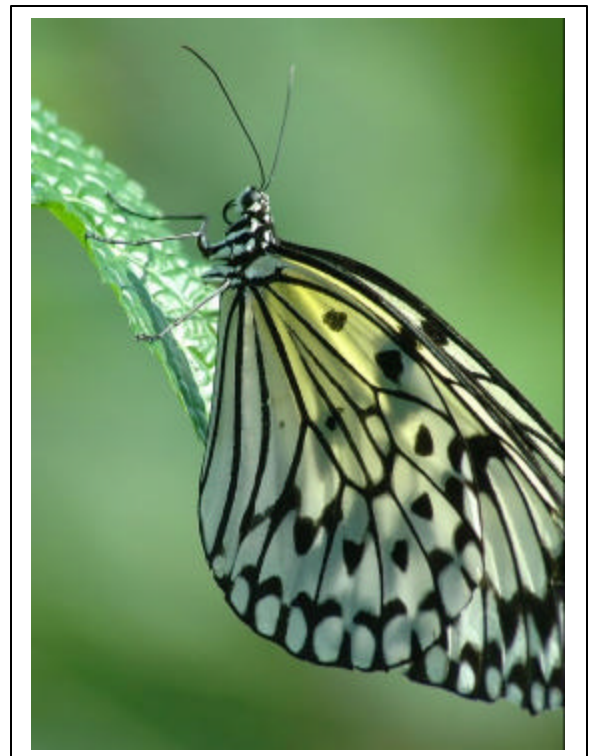
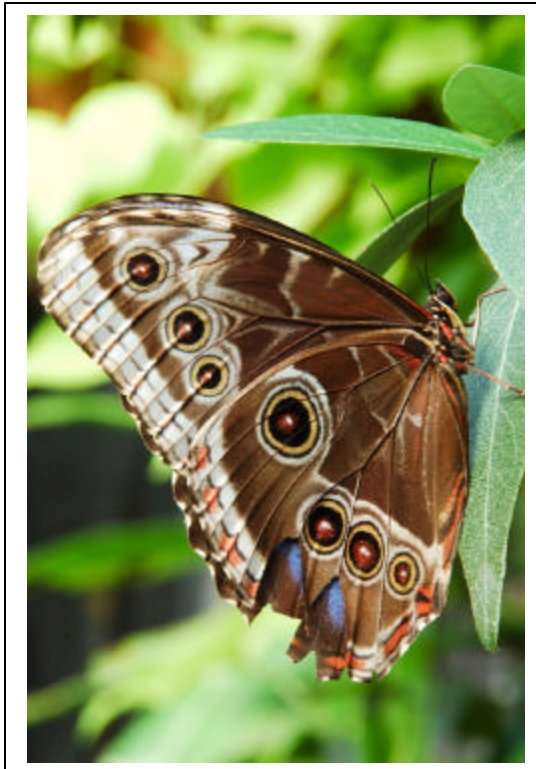

Soft, citrus pastels are wonderful combinations to use.



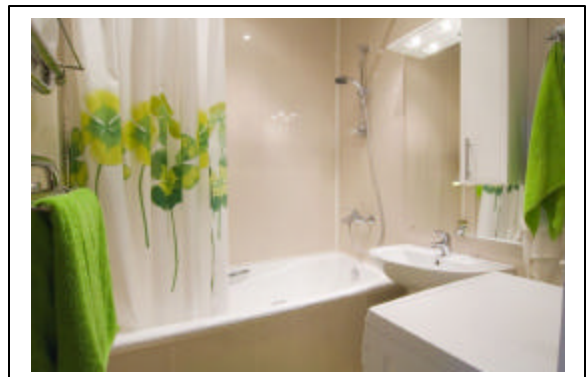
How about these butterflies? Both are gorgeous. One is a rich chocolate brown

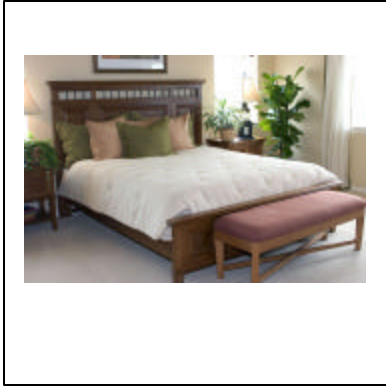
